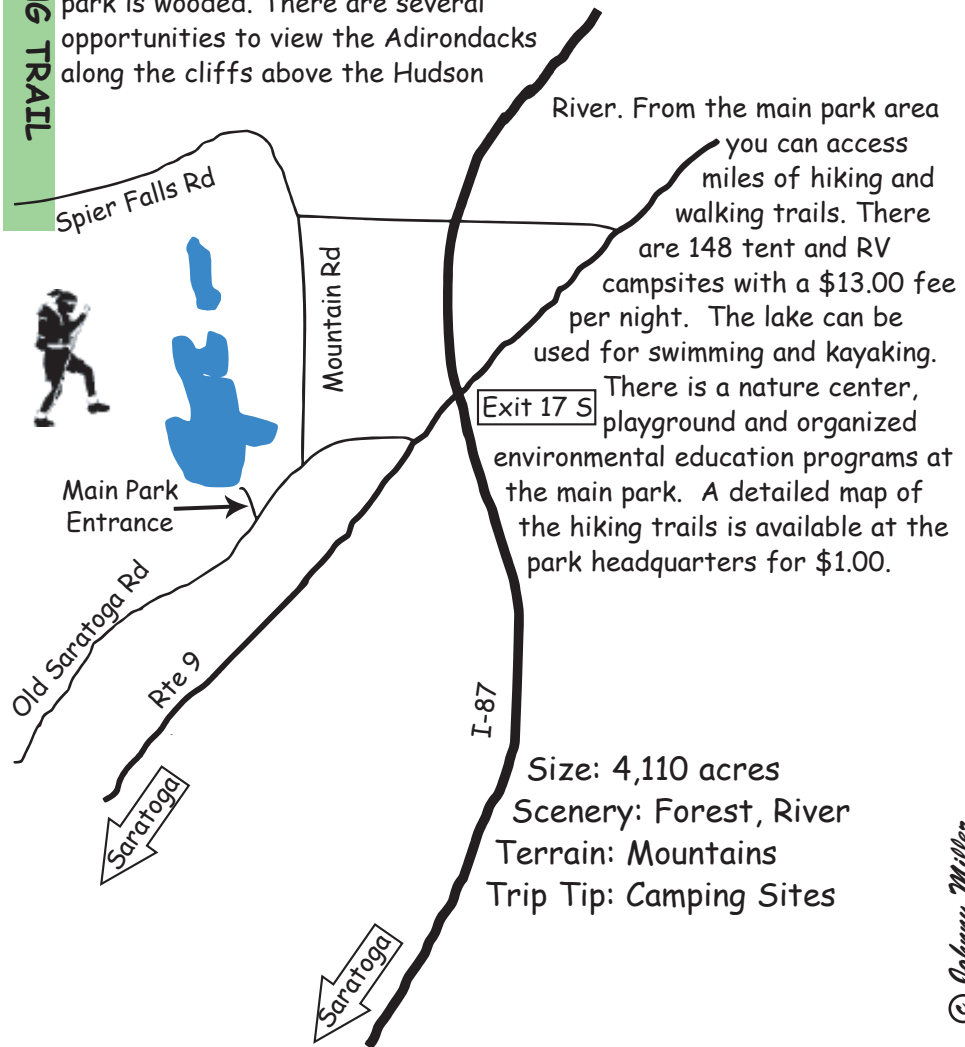


# Moreau Lake State Park

## HIKING TRAIL

With the recent acquisition of 3,216 acres of open space in Saratoga and Warren counties, Moreau is now the ninth largest State Park in New York with a total of 4,110 acres. This includes 14 miles of shoreline along the Hudson River. Most of the park is wooded. There are several opportunities to view the Adirondacks along the cliffs above the Hudson



Directions: From Saratoga go north out of town on Rte 9 which runs parallel with I-87. Continue on Rte 9 for 12 miles until the road turns west toward I-87 and South Glens Falls. The park entrance road is on the left just before you cross over the interstate. Follow the signs to the park entrance.
