CHAMBER INCREASES PROGRAMMING THROUGHOUT SARATOGA COUNTY

The Saratoga County Chamber is the largest Chamber in the Capital Region and is respected for being effective, accessible, inclusive and connected to all of the communities within our County. This is one of the six key initiatives included in the Chamber's new strategic plan as adopted by the Board of Directors earlier this year. While the Chamber has always been a vocal and visible promoter of all of our members and all of the communities in Saratoga County, we're now increasing programming throughout Saratoga County as noted below:

Mixers in Clifton Park – In June and August, we hosted networking mixers at Wheatfields Bistro and Wine Bar and Pasta Pane, in Clifton Park, which were well attended and greatly appreciated by those in attendance.

Networking Breakfast – Our September Third Thursday Breakfast, which featured a presentation by John O'Donnell, CEO of the Albany International Airport was hosted at the Comfort Suites in Clifton Park.

Business Development Groups – We have formed two new Business Development Groups with up to 25 people in and south of Malta to complement our other leads groups.

Tourism Promotion – Beyond advertising related to Summer at Saratoga, the Chamber promotes the Saratoga National Historic Battlefield, our state parks, local and national museums located in Saratoga County, self-guided farm tours, golf courses, hiking and biking trails, whitewater rafting, etc. Our maps, brochures, and website promotions are viewed annually by millions of visitors and prospective visitors in person and online.

Partnerships – The Chamber coordinates semi-annual networking events for the Ballston Spa, Burnt Hills/Ballston Lake, Greenfield and Malta Business and Professional Associations. Our staff now serves on the Board of Directors of several of these organizations.

Member Services – We have members throughout Saratoga County who purchase health insurance through the Chamber; lower their energy costs by participating in the Chamber's Energy Alliance Program; post jobs or volunteer opportunities for free on our Job Zone; and have taken advantage of the free business counseling provided in our offices by SCORE and the SBDC.
