ENHANCED DRIVERS LICENSE The new enhanced drivers license (EDL) lasts for eight years and will cost \$80. The fee is \$30 more than the current drivers license fee. These EDL's can be used for land and sea border crossings in Canada, Mexico, Bermuda and the Caribbean. Beginning June 1, 2009, only a handful of documents will be acceptable for border crossing, and the New York State EDL will be one of them. They will be issued beginning in September.
