In 2011, we made history in the way we promoted Saratoga County. We produced New York's first Lip Dub which has been seen by tens of thousands of people online all over the world. A trip to Saratoga County during the Travers Weekend was a featured prize in The Price is Right's Showcase Showdown in 2011 thanks to the Chamber, Saratoga Arms, and NYRA. The Chamber also secured a grant to enable Saratoga PLAN to create the first online countywide map of hiking, biking and snowmobile trails across Saratoga County.

This year, the Chamber played a leading role in facilitating a public-private partnership to build a long-sought after parking

deck in downtown Saratoga Springs. We partnered with the Albany, Schenectady and Rensselaer Chambers of Commerce, the Center for Economic Growth, the Albany International Airport, our US Senators and Capital Region Congressmen to secure a \$750,000 federal grant and \$500,000 in local matching funds to create an incentive program to help us attract new carriers, new direct flights and lower prices for flights to and from Albany. We sent a delegation of 55 people to China and hosted three seminars to help local companies learn how to sell across cultures as our county becomes a global destination for tourists, talent and trade.

Our success begins with 2,700 members who remain loyal to the Chamber and among the best corporate citizens you'll find anywhere in the world. Our success is then made possible by the extraordinary commitment of time and energy by our volunteers on the Board of Directors, the Membership Committee, and our Ambassadors.
