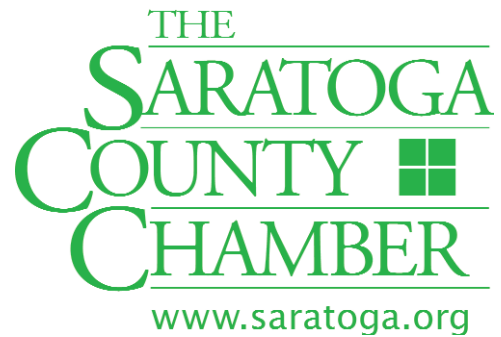

## LEADERSHIP 2007/2008

Leadership Saratoga, a program of your Saratoga County Chamber, has a compelling story to tell. Its graduates have been making a positive impact on organizations, schools and communities throughout this county for over 21 years.

In this past year alone, 52 Leadership Saratoga alumni have been elected or appointed to local Boards of Education, Town Boards, City Councils, the County Board of Supervisors, the County Planning Board, and various other municipal committees. Thirteen work in politically appointed positions. Graduates also serve on the Boards of Directors of 59 non-profit organizations from all over the region, and volunteer for over 150 additional organizations, schools, religious institutions and youth sports programs annually.

Leadership Saratoga is a program designed to orient and train persons who are interested in becoming more involved in their community in volunteer leadership capacities.

The program is currently seeking applicants for its 22nd class. You are encouraged to request a brochure about the program and to consider applying.

The program's objectives are threefold:

- (1) To give participants an in-depth, hands-on orientation about issues facing the County's municipalities, schools, health and human service organizations;
- (2) To give participants training and experience in serving effectively on boards, raising money, public speaking, working with the media, facing ethical dilemmas and leadership skills;
- (3) To offer non-profits and public service boards an enthusiastic, committed group of men and women who are willing to volunteer their time to the community.

The program is competitive and countywide. We are seeking applicants who are eager to sharpen their volunteer leadership skills and volunteer in the community. This is not a management-training program.

Anyone interested in additional details about the program is encouraged to attend an optional information meeting on May 16th from 5 to 6 p.m. at the Saratoga County Chamber. Recent graduates of the program will describe their experiences and answer questions.

Tuition is \$995 which includes an overnight retreat and the thirteen half-day sessions. Financial assistance is possible.
